2008-2009 Exam Dates

The table at the beginning of the operator training and testing calendar contains a list of examination dates for the upcoming year. **These testing opportunities are the only ones that will be scheduled for the year. No other exams will be scheduled.**

Applications must be completed and legible. Incomplete applications will not be processed.

All statements and information provided on the exam application must be correct and true to the best of your knowledge and may be subject to verification by your current and/or past employer.

The exam application along with the \$25.00 exam fee must be received in our office prior to the application deadline.

All applications must include a detailed current and past work history describing your water and/or wastewater work experience. A current copy of your resume that includes your water and/or your wastewater work history can also be submitted along with the application.

The application must be signed by both the applicant and the applicant's supervisor.

All applicants must have either a high school diploma or GED to be eligible to take the exam. KDHE may randomly request that you send a copy of your high school diploma or GED for verification.

Eligibility to take the exam when based on college education requires the applicant to send KDHE a copy of an official transcript.

Photo Identification and KDHE approval letter are required at the exam site.

Do you have an e-mail account? By providing your e-mail address on your exam application, KDHE will notify you by both e-mail and mail when your application has been approved, or if further documentation is needed to process your application. This should speed up the approval process.

Exams R Us

With the completion of the Water Operator Job Analysis, as well as review of water operator exam questions by the KDHE Advisory Committee, KDHE is revising the water operator certification exams. The revised exams will better reflect the work performed by Kansas water operators and the knowledge and skills that operators need to be successful on the job.

KDHE will begin administering new water operator exams this fall.

Frequently Asked Questions

How do I become a Kansas certified water or wastewater operator?

Each operator must meet the following requirements:

- 1) Currently own or be employed by a water supply system or wastewater treatment facility.
- 2) Have a high school diploma or GED.
- 3) Have acquired the minimum number of years of experience for the class of examination desired.
- 4) Have acquired the minimum number of *points* for the class of examination desired. Points are awarded based on experience, education, and training.

Is training required prior to taking a certification exam?

While training is not a requirement prior to certification, KDHE believes that training is helpful in obtaining initial certification.

Where can I find study material to study for certification exams?

KDHE recommends the water and wastewater training manuals published by the University of California – Sacramento. The Web site for these manuals is www.owp.csus.edu

KDHE also has Kansas Small System Water and Wastewater manuals. To request a copy please contact our office.

How can I obtain an Application for Water or Wastewater Certification Exam?

You can obtain an application from KDHE's Web site www.kdheks.gov/water/www.html or by contacting our office.

Why does the exam application have to be mailed to KDHE two weeks before the exam date?

We have to screen all applications to ensure the applicants meet the minimum qualifications for the examination. With as many as 200 examinations given at one test site, two weeks is the minimum time necessary to evaluate the applications and prepare examination packets for each applicant.

Additionally, all exams must be paid for before exam results will be mailed.

How many hours does an operator need to attend to renew their certificate?

Small System operators are required to acquire five hours every two years.

Class I-IV operators are required to acquire 10 hours every two years.

What type of training do I need to attend?

Training must be related to the subject matter of the certificate. If the training is pertinent to water supply and wastewater operators (pump maintenance, for example), KDHE will split the total hours between water and wastewater credit, unless the operator specifies otherwise.

How do I know if the training has been approved by KDHE?

All the training listed on the attached training calendar has been approved by KDHE. For other training not listed on the training calendar, verify with the training provider that the training has been approved by KDHE.

What if the required training is not acquired before the renewal expiration date?

The certificate cannot be renewed, and the operator is no longer certified. The certificate can be reinstated up to two years following expiration as long as the required training is obtained and the reinstatement fee is paid.

What training records should I keep?

Although KDHE maintains individual operator training records from cooperating training providers, it is the operator's responsibility for maintaining their own training records. Documentation of attendance at each training event should be maintained.

Can an operator check their own renewal and training information?

KDHE has established real-time Internet access to operator data. To access the operator database, go to www.kdheks.gov/water/www.html and click on Certified Operator Database. Once you have gained access to the operator database, you will be able to review operator renewal dates and continuing education hours. Operators can also e-mail KDHE changes of address, employment, etc. directly from the site.

Emergency Technical Assistance for Operators-in-Training (OIT) Program

Public water supply systems that serve a population of 3,300 or less and loses their sole certified operator, should contact Teresa Schuyler, (785) 296-5511 or Vickie Wessel, (785) 296-2976. Certain systems may qualify for emergency technical assistance through a KDHE contractor.

Kansas Backup Operator Program (KBOP)

It's not too late to participate! Public water supply systems that serve a population of 3,300 or less and have only one certified water operator, could be eligible to receive financial assistance to obtain training and certification for a backup operator. K.A.R. 28-16-33(a)(1)
Requires that each system or facility shall have an individual or individuals in responsible charge at the system or facility site, or available at all times.

You must notify KDHE immediately of any change in the certified operator.
